PRESIDENT'S HEADLIGHTS..... **Share The Driving!!**

This is the first big weekend coming up – the Carlson Center member car show! As I write this column, over half of the show spaces in the Center are reserved and all vendor spaces are sold. Rod Benson and his crew are doing a great job this year with the planning and preparation of our event. If you have not yet reserved a space, please call Rod right away 687-1543. Consider volunteering to “share the driving” and/or work one of the jobs at the show. Selling tickets for the raffle car during the show is another area we could use your help in.

When bringing your car or cars to the Carlson Center on Friday, please try to be there early. Registration will be set up in the back lot at 4:00 pm. Cars will move into the Center (in order by vintage) starting promptly at 5:30 pm (*you must have your car on the floor on Friday – you can't just show up with a car on Saturday or during the show*). When you bring your car, you must sign a statement that there is less than 1/8 tank of gasoline and you also have liability insurance on your car. When you set

the car up, you must have a fire extinguisher sitting outside the car (under the right rear tire is pretty standard), and you must disconnect the battery. Cars may be removed from the Carlson Center at 5:00 pm on Sunday.

Coming up fast is our annual Poker Run to Gary & Jill Nash's cabin on Saturday 6/11 – and then the big Joint Alaska Meet at the Rivers' Edge Resort on Father's Day Weekend (Friday evening and Saturday 6/17 & 6/18). 
CARLSON CENTER SHOW INFO

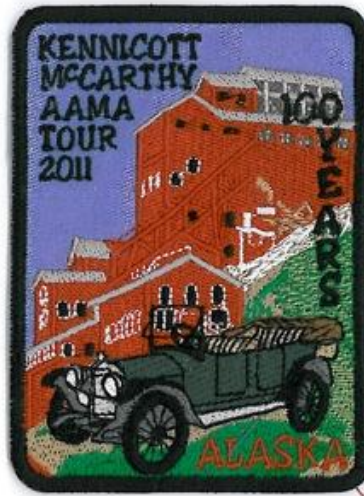

Jerry and Louis run the foundry by themselves except in the summer months when business is at its highest. J & T Foundry is a green sand foundry and they specialize in Bronze and Aluminum casting.

At J & T Foundry and Design, they are able to manufacture many types of castings for industrial use. Some of these include, but are not limited to bushings, impellers, thrust washers, pump housings and stove doors. Your castings can be made from patterns that you provide or they can have them made for you. The rough castings can either be sent to the machine shop of your choice to be machined or they work closely with local machine shops to provide you with a totally finished product.

J & T Foundry has on hand the following alloys:
 C93200 Sae 660 (general purpose bushing, washers, non-pressure applications).
 C87500 Silicon Bronze substituted for tin-zinc bronzes.
 95400 Aluminum Bronze spur and low speed, heavily loaded worm gears, nuts, pumps and landing gear parts.
 C92200 Leaded tin bronze medium pressure hydraulic and steam to 550 degree F. marine and ornamental castings.
 Aluminum 356 Primary and Secondary
 Any other nonferrous metals will be considered on a case by case basis.
 They can pour up to 800 lbs. of brass or 250 lbs. of aluminum in a single pour.
 Two of our members have had work done by J & T Foundry, engine parts and decorative trim. Those that have had work done at the foundry have been happy to have a local business to work with.
