CLASSICS: Quality cars so designated by the Classic Car Club of America

VINTAGE SPORTS: High-performance cars so designated by the Vintage Sports Car Club of America

### POST-WORLD WAR II

PRODUCTION: Assembly-line cars popular for their age or special features

MILESTONES: Cars of outstanding design or engineering, designated by the Milestone Car Society
