TREADS ON THE TUNDRA

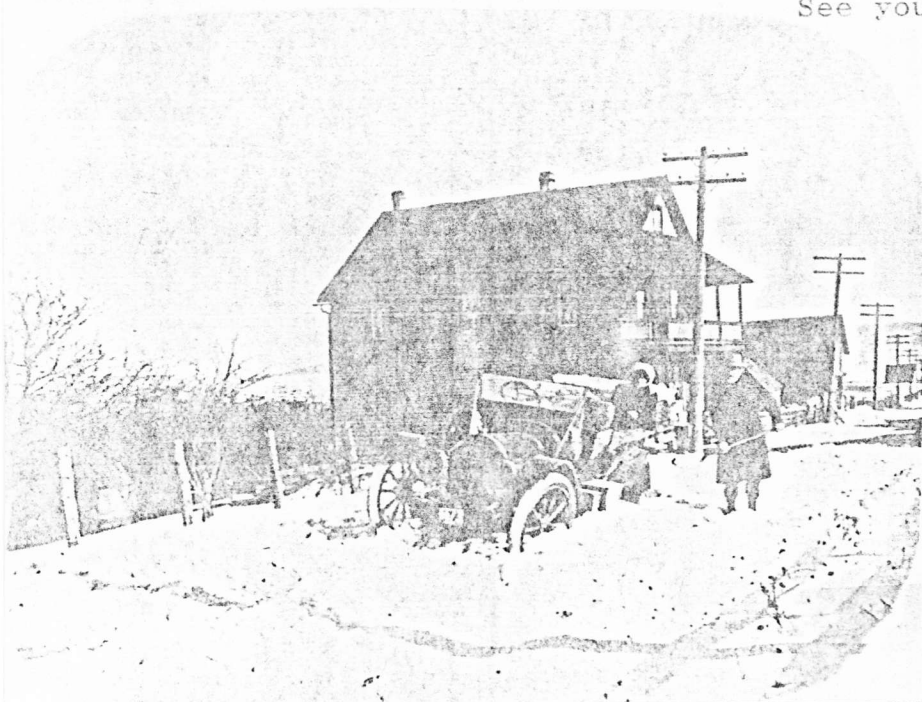
End of hibernation is at hand! The thermometer has been above 50 below for more than a month, so it is high time to think about antique automobiles and club activities.
