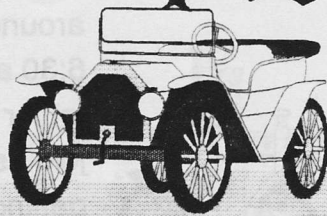

Aurora Show 'N Shine

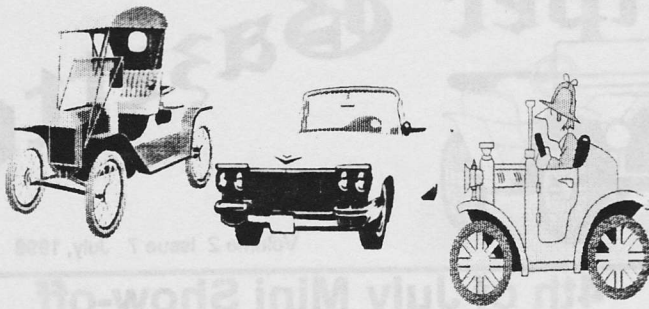
