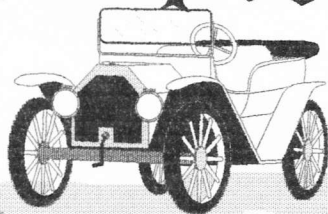

## ELECTIONS!!

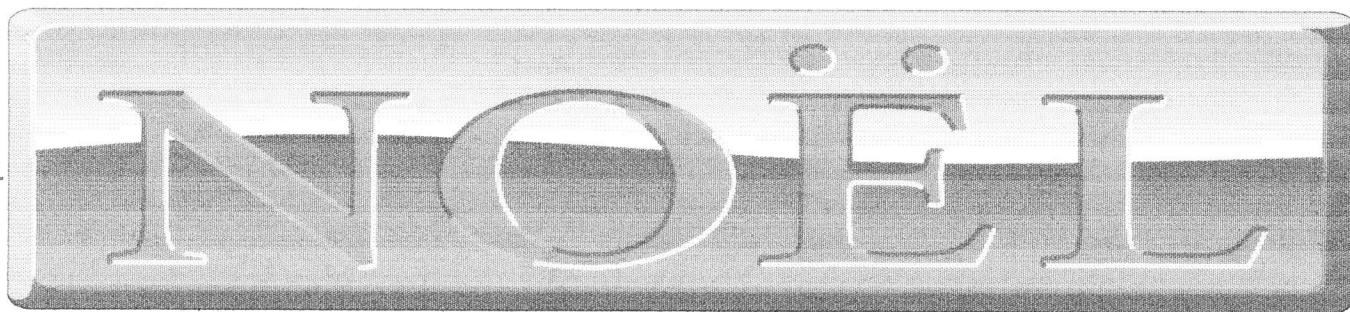

### A little Humor

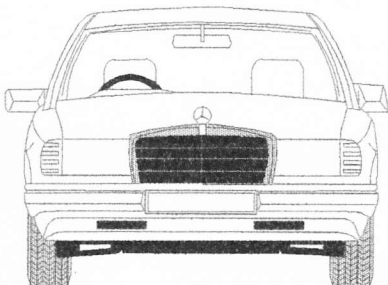
A friend wh has a tree farm often hires itinerant workers. He told me this story in all seriousness, although I did detect a twinkle in one eye.
