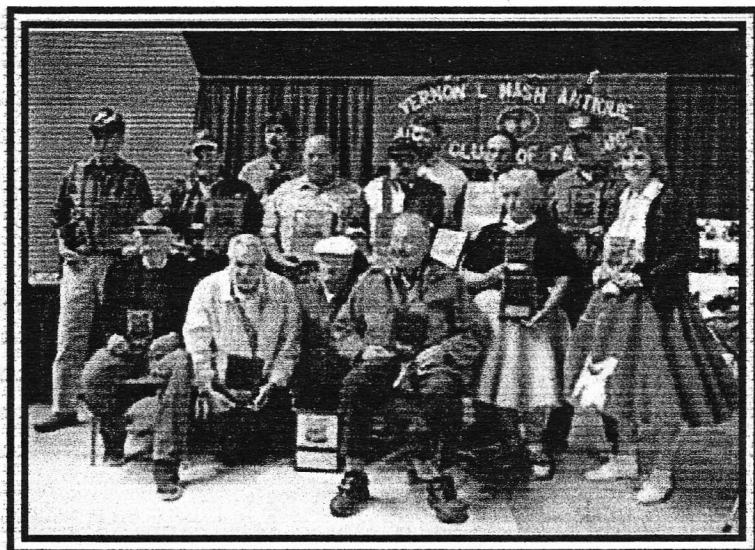
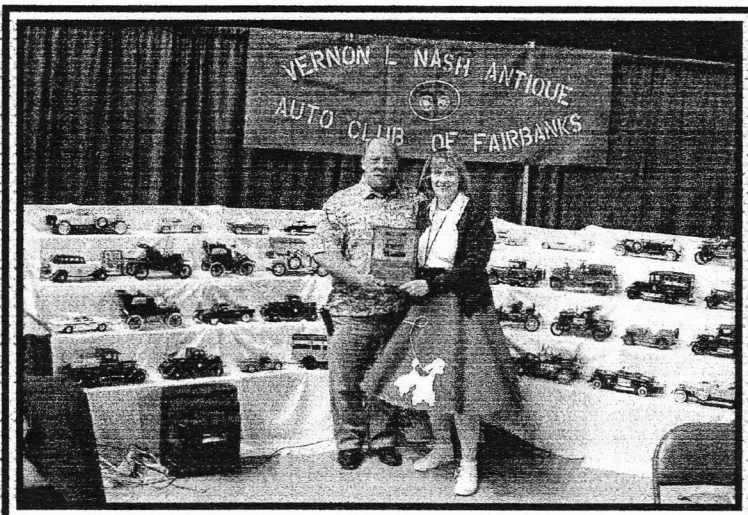

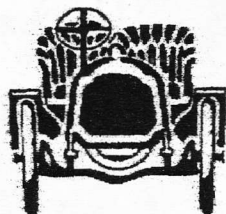
6/11-13/04 Summer Joint meet with VLNAACF and AAMA at Trapper Creek Inn. I have information now on reservations for this event that is why it is included here.
